

WHAT DO WE NEED TO DO

Your home will be treated for bedbugs using out Temp-Air heat treatment. On the day of the treatment please be out of your home by 8am. Plan to be out of your home for at least 8 hours. As soon as the treatment is completed you can return.

Some clothing, linens and furniture may be moved in the process of treating your home. We apologize for any inconvenience, but this is necessary to ensure the most effective treatment of your home.

Please follow the instructions below to prepare for the treatment.

Take house plants and pets (including cats, dogs, fish, birds etc.) out of the home.

Move fruits, vegetables, all other fresh food and gel-tablet vitamins / over the counter medication to the refrigerator.

Move food that may melt (chocolate, candy etc.) to the refrigerator.

Move food that is pressurized into the fridge or out of your home. (beer, pop, wine, etc.)

Take all medication not stored in the fridge with you (medication stored in the fridge that you do not need that day can be left in the fridge)

Pack the following into a box that our staff can store outside of your home while treating it.

cosmetics (lipstick , eyeshadow etc.)

wax based items (candles, crayons, oil paintings)

spray cans (hairspray, insect spray)

flammables (lighters, lamp fuel, rubbing alcohol, solvents, gun powder, ammunition etc.)

Remove musical instruments that may be damaged by heat (violins, clarinets guitars etc.)

Family heirlooms and irreplaceable items should be removed from the home.

Turn off and unplug all electronics from the outlet (television, DVD player, computer, radio etc.)

Clear door openings of any obstruction - Easy access to all rooms and closets is required.

Hang as much clothing in the closet as possible. Leave bedding on beds.

Place loose papers in boxes (powerful fans will be used that could scatter papers)

Deflate everything inflated by air (air mattresses, air pillows, beach balls etc.)

Remove all bed linens and pillow cases from every bed in your home. Yes, even the spare room where nobody ever goes, and put them in bags.

Remove all clothing from dresser drawers and put them in bags.

Remove all **CLOTHING** from closets, from waist level down. Items hanging are ok, unless they touch the floor, in which case bag them as well. Items on upper shelf are ok to leave.

All of the linens and clothing will need to be washed and put thru the dryer for a minimum of 30 minutes. You **DO NOT** have to have this done before we arrive. You may do this in between services if you like., it does not matter to us.

Any clothing or backpacks you take with you when you leave the home must be put in a clothes dryer for at least 30 minutes on the highest heat setting before bringing them back in your home.
