

WHAT DO WE NEED TO DO

On _____ your unit will be receiving treatment for bedbugs. Our technician will be arriving to your unit between _____.

All people and pets must be prepared to be out of your unit after completion of the treatment for at least 6 hours. Pregnant women, infants and/or persons with respiratory conditions or immune deficiencies are encouraged to stay out of the unit for at least 24 hours.

THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RULES.

Please ensure the following preparations are completed before your treatment.

You will require some type of bags for prep. Garbage bags will do fine

1. Remove all bed linens and pillow cases from every bed in your home. Yes, even the spare room where nobody ever goes, and put them in bags.
2. Remove all clothing from dresser drawers and put them in bags.
3. Remove all **CLOTHING** from closets, from waist level down. Items hanging are ok, unless they touch the floor, in which case bag them as well. Items on upper shelf are ok to leave.
4. All of the linens and clothing will need to be washed and put thru the dryer for a minimum of 30 minutes. You **DO NOT** have to have this done before we arrive. You may do this in between services if you like., it does not matter to us.
5. Please remove any other items (knick knacks, books, change etc.) from side tables and drawers in the bedrooms only. You may bag these items or put them in a box.
6. Pull out any under bed storage boxes and leave out for treatment. Please empty them if they have any clothing or linens etc. inside of them.
7. Pull out all luggage, handbags, purses etc. that may have been or have not been used for travel.
8. Shoes: Please pull them out of closets exposing the base boards.
9. Bookcases, display cabinets, office material, desks etc. do not need to be prepped. Our technicians are equipped with the latest treatment equipment for such items.
10. Please shut down and unplug all computers.

11. If you live in a condo or shared dwelling, DO NOT throw anything out until after our technicians arrive. Either A: Live bedbugs, eggs etc. may fall off into common areas and B: Our staff can probably save it from being thrown out.
12. Launder all bedding and clothing (see below for instructions)
13. All floor areas must be clutter free (including closets and beneath furniture)
14. Vacuum all floor areas and baseboards (including closets): place vacuum bag in plastic bag, seal and discard immediately in outside garbage bin.
15. Clear all food items off counter tops, and store in fridge or cupboards.
16. If you have a fish tank, it should be covered with a wet towel and the pump turned off for at least 6 hours.

After the treatment is complete it is okay to vacuum and/or sweep, but do not wash the floors for 2 weeks as this may eliminate the residual that has been applied. Remember to properly discard vacuum bag as mentioned above.
